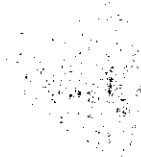

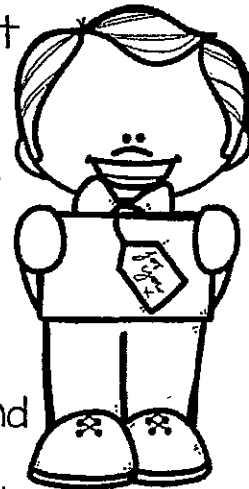

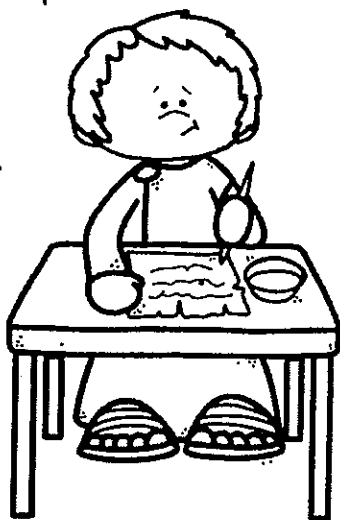
VALENTINE'S DAY

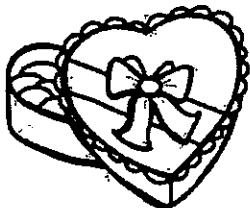
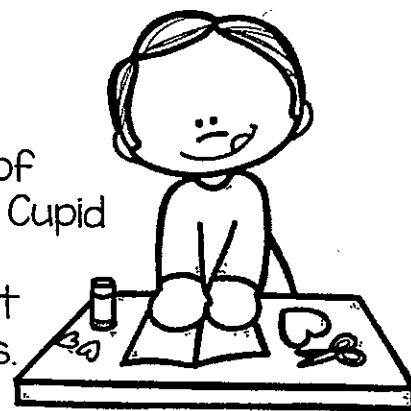


ORIGIN

Roman Emperor **Claudius II** banned marriage long ago. A priest named **Valentine** wanted to help people in love. He **married** couples in secret so the **emperor** sentenced him to death. Valentine wrote a letter to the girl he loved while he was in prison. He signed it, "from your Valentine." He was killed on February 14 around the year 270. Valentine's Day became a **Christian** holiday during the 400s. It is celebrated by many people today on February 14.

TRADITIONS

People trade **cards** or love letters on Valentine's Day. Many are decorated with hearts. A picture of **Cupid** holding a bow and arrow are also common. Cupid was the **Roman** god of love. Some couples get **engaged** to be married on this day. Many go out for special dinners and often give each other gifts. Red **roses** and boxes of **chocolates** are often



given to loved ones. Many classrooms have parties on Valentine's Day and children exchange gifts. Valentine's Day is a fun holiday for many people.

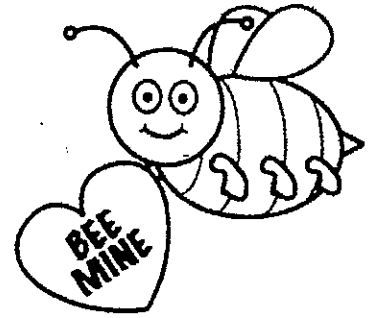
