
Dear Jake,

Derrick and Tiffany Lang coming to you from Irvine, CA. Your mom and Derrick's mom, Debbie, are cousins. I think that makes you and Derrick second cousins. We are so excited to participate in your school project. I have the whole week off, in honor of Presidents' Week, so I have plenty of time to write to you and share a little bit about Irvine.

Derrick and I have lived in Irvine for about 6 years. We live on the border of Irvine and Tustin. Irvine became an incorporated city in 1971. It has 66 miles of land with an average annual rainfall between 10 and 13 inches. So technically, Irvine has a semi-desert climate. The average temperature in January is 56 degrees and 71 degrees in August.

We have some official city symbols including: the Camphor tree, Lily of the Nile, Asparagus (our official city vegetable) and the Western Swallowtail butterfly. We have several parks in Irvine (56 to be exact), and 5,200 acres of open space nature preserves.

Irvine has a population of around 223,000 people. However, during the week between 8:00 and 5:00, the population increases by 150%.
